New Security Screening Procedures for Children 12 and Under

Effective Sunday, September 25, children 12 and under may leave their shoes on during security screening at all Oregon airports. Transportation Security Administration (TSA) officers will also have more options to resolve any alarms that may occur during the screening process; thereby reducing the number of physical pat-downs for children.

The new security procedures are part of an effort by the TSA to streamline procedures for lower risk passengers. The TSA stresses that the new procedures will not eliminate the need for all pat-downs on children, and there will still be times that shoes might have to come off.
